PREAMBLE


Recognising the mutual benefits to be gained through a cooperative programme promoting scholarly activities and international understanding, Belgrade University, through the department of **Faculty of Technology and Metallurgy**, and **SSS Indira College of Pharmacy, Vishnupuri, Nanded, India** will enter into this academic cooperation agreement. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to record formally this mutual interest of Belgrade University and SSS Indira College of Pharmacy, Vishnupuri, Nanded, India in exploring, for a period of Five years following signature of this MoU, collaborative research, training and capacity building to address research opportunities in the Serbia and India, for the mutual benefits of both parties and in investigating funding sources to realise these opportunities.

OBJECTIVES

This cooperation (MoU) concerns the subject area of joint teaching and research collaboration and may include the following activities.

- a) Organising, promoting, staffing and coordinating long and short-term staff and student exchanges and other academic activities, provided that all participants are appropriately qualified and there are adequate financial resources.
- b) Facilitating and coordinating joint research cooperation and curriculum development.
- c) Organising seminars, academic interactive sessions, and other professional development activities.
- d) Coordinating special short-term academic programmes, including short-term seminars to introduce staff and students of the institutions to general cultural activities and other areas of specialised learning.
- e) Enhancing the capacity of the two Universities to carry out relevant research and to secure the required external funding for same.
- 1) Under this agreement various Faculties, Departments, Centres and Units of partner institutions will be able to collaborate in areas that will be of mutual benefit.





IMPLEMENTATION

Each institute shall designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programmes. The terms of such mutual assistance and the necessary budget for each specific programme and activity that is to be implemented under the terms of this MoU shall be discussed and agreed, and written into a legally binding agreement prior to the initiation of the programme or activity and any such agreement shall be reviewed at agreed intervals.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS, RESULTS AND PUBLICATIONS

Each party shall continue to remain the sole owner of all materials it contributes in any joint project. The parties will work together to negotiate appropriate licensing terms.

DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1) This MoU shall become effective on the date that it is signed by both parties and shall be valid for Five years.
- 2) Any changes to this MoU shall be subject to the written consent of both parties.
- 3) This MoU may be terminated by either party at any time provided that the party who wishes to terminate gives written notice of its intention at least three months prior to termination.
- 4) Nothing in the above MoU shall be construed as legally binding.


CONFIDENTIALITY





MUTUAL NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between "**Indira College of Pharmacy**", with its principal place of business at "Vishnupuri, Nanded, Maharashtra, 431606, India" (the "Company") and **DFE Pharma GmbH & Co. KG**, a German limited partnership with its principal place of business at Klever Straße 187, 47574 Goch ("DFE").

The Company and DFE intend to evaluate their possible interest to enter into any form of commercial relationship between them relating to excipients used in 3D printing and 3D printing applications and equipment. In the course of such discussions and negotiations, it is anticipated that each party may disclose or deliver to the other certain trade secrets or other confidential or proprietary information for the purpose of enabling the other to evaluate the feasibility and desirability of establishing such a commercial relationship, or either party may otherwise gain access to trade secrets or other confidential or proprietary information of the other. The Company and DFE have entered into this Agreement in order to assure the continued confidentiality of such trade secrets or other information in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. As used in this Agreement, the term "Proprietary Information" shall mean all confidential or proprietary information, and proprietary materials, of one party (the "Disclosing Party"), including trade secrets, know-how, formulations, techniques, equipment, data reports, computer software, and information regarding sources of purchase and supply, patent positioning, business plans, and the existence, scope and activities of any research, development, manufacturing, marketing or other projects of the Disclosing Party (including negative developments), to which the obligations of the other party (the "Recipient") under this Agreement shall apply in accordance with paragraph 2.
2. The obligations of the Recipient under this Agreement shall apply to all Proprietary Information of the Disclosing Party which has been or may hereafter be disclosed, directly or indirectly, to the Recipient by the Disclosing Party, either orally or in writing, or delivered to the Recipient.
3. The Recipient and its personnel shall use Proprietary Information only to the extent necessary to determine the feasibility and desirability of establishing a commercial relationship with the Disclosing Party, and shall not use or exploit Proprietary Information for its or their own benefit or of another party without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. The Recipient shall disclose or deliver Proprietary Information only to persons within its organization who have a need to know the same in the

course of performance of their duties and who are bound by a written agreement to protect the confidentiality thereof.

4. The Recipient shall not directly or indirectly disclose, communicate or in any way divulge to any other person or entity any Proprietary Information (or, if the Recipient is not an individual, permit or suffer its personnel to do so).  - (b) is rightfully in the Recipient's possession prior to the time of disclosure or acquisition, and the Recipient's intended use or disclosure would not violate any restriction on use or disclosure binding on the Recipient;
 - (c) is rightfully made available to the Recipient by others, and the Recipient's intended use or disclosure would not violate any restriction on use or disclosure binding on the Recipient, or
 - (d) is disclosed by the Recipient in order to comply with the requirements of applicable law or governmental regulation, provided that the Recipient gives the Disclosing Party prior written notice of such disclosure and takes reasonable actions to avoid such disclosure or minimize its extent.
6. The Recipient agrees that the Disclosing Party is and shall remain the exclusive owner of all Proprietary Information and all patent, copyright, trade secret, trademark and other intellectual property rights therein. No license or conveyance of any such rights to the Recipient is granted or implied under this Agreement.
7. The Disclosing Party represents and warrants that by making any disclosure under this Agreement it does not violate any legal obligation by which it is bound.
8. This Agreement will end 10 years from the date of execution hereof by both Parties, but without affecting the liability of either party hereto for breach of the Agreement before then.
9. Upon termination of this Agreement or at the request of the Disclosing Party, the Recipient shall promptly deliver to the Disclosing Party all drawings, data, memoranda and other tangible manifestations of, and all materials constituting, Proprietary Information (and all copies and reproductions thereof).


